

Łukasz Żelechowski is Assistant Professor at the University of Warsaw, Faculty of Law and Administration, Department of Intellectual Property Law. He is also Of Counsel at LDS Łazewski Depo i Wspólnicy, Warsaw, and Arbitrator at the Arbitration Court for Domain Names at the Polish Chamber of Information Technology and Telecommunications. He is qualified Polish patent attorney. He was scholarship holder at the Max-Planck-Institute for Innovation and Competition in Munich (2007) and guest lecturer at the University of Ottawa, Faculty of Law (2012, lectures on International Industrial Property Law).

Łukasz Żelechowski specializes in intellectual property law with focus on industrial property law. He authored (or co-authored) several books and a number of articles in this field, in particular on trade mark infringement, unfair competition law, civil law liability for infringement of intellectual property rights, protection of EU-wide intellectual property rights, establishing security interests over industrial property rights.
